

Internet-Based Services Policy for Participants

Family Futures Resource Network takes seriously the protection of your privacy, and we follow a strict policy never to share your personal information without your express permission. That extends to our use of internet-based services (such as Zoom and YouTube) to deliver programs to you. However, we want to remind you that any such technologies are subject to their own privacy policies concerning any information you may choose to share directly with them, and encourage you to be aware of their policies and share only what you feel comfortable sharing.

We want you to feel safe when you participate in Family Futures Resource Networks programs where we use Zoom or similar services. We will employ all the features of those services which may prevent or control the intrusion of unwanted content (e.g., “Zoom bombing”), including restricting participation to those who have registered in our program.

Even with diligent use of such controls, it is impossible to guarantee that a participant will not share information that other participants find offensive. Should that occur, we will take swift and firm action to stop or limit such occurrences. Beyond those actions, Family Futures will not accept additional responsibility.

Your registration in any Family Futures program which uses internet-based services will be understood to be your acceptance of this policy.
